

Parish Sacramental Programs



Every year, our parish offers sacramental programs for First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation reception.

St Mary MacKillop College primarily prepares their students for these sacraments in the age-appropriate classes. However, sometimes with new enrolments there are students who have missed receiving a sacrament, so the students attend an out-of-school program with those who attend another school system. Lessons are run at the same time students are being prepared at St Mary MacKillop College so they receive the sacrament the same time as them.

Our parish led program comes from the Bunbury Diocese and is designed to be used by a Catechist or parents. It has a parent reflection component and questions which help the parent to connect the topics which are linked to Gospel readings. There are also activity worksheets.

Parents or Caregivers are also involved in the Enrolment Mass, plus General and Sacramental Meetings with our priests and the teaching staff from the College. There is always a Thanksgiving Mass or Celebration of the Co-Hort. Students participate with their parents at their Sacramental Meeting. The College also has a Retreat Day for all Confirmation Candidates before their Sacramental Reception. These events are times of creativity for all involved.
